Educational Website Evaluation: Brainscape and Quizlet

The constant rapid evolution of digital technology, especially in the educational sector, has transformed its instructional curriculum and offered new avenues for learning and teaching to enhance students' needs. As a result, a myriad of new tools of learning are constantly being developed to meet the changing pace of learning. Among the different educational tools available, flashcards remain one of the most effective methods utilized for easy memorization and facilitating active recall (Karpicke & Roediger, 2008). Although traditional paper-based flashcards are useful, these new tools have given way to digital flashcard applications which offer additional functionalities such as gamification, collaborative study modes, and adaptive learning. According to Cepeda et al. (2008), flashcard-based learning allows students to comprehend the material at a faster pace. The emergence of digital flashcards is implemented on many platforms with Brainscape (see appendix, figure 1) and Quizlet (see appendix, figure 2) being the more popular choices for learners.

Brainscape located at the following URL: ([Brainscape: The Best Flashcards App | Make Flashcards Online](#)) is a web-based and mobile flashcard platform that is designed to optimize the learner's knowledge retention through its adaptive learning system known as spaced repetition. According to Brainscape (2025), space repetition is a learning technique that focuses on reviewing harder materials more frequently, ensuring continuous reinforcement of weaker areas of knowledge. After evaluating this platform, the primary goal of Brainscape is to accelerate cognitive processing and enhance the learner's retention efficiency. The platform provides ready-made and user-created flashcards covering a multitude of academic and professional topics including test preparation such as GRE, LSAT, and SAT. This platform entices students with the goal of having a more structured approach to learning their material. Additionally, Brainscape

uses a rating scheme for learners to rate their understanding of the material from 1-5 which enables the website algorithm to prioritize their weaker areas of learning. Unlike that of traditional flashcard-based learning, Brainscape continues to optimize the learning process by making it more efficient, purposeful, and personalized. By leveraging its adaptive spaced repetition system, Brainscape conforms to each learner's level of learning and ensures that challenging concepts are reinforced. Compared to that of traditional flashcard methods, Brainscape's approach to flashcard-based learning provides users with a more personalized learning experience that aligns with the learner's learning objective.


Quizlet, which can be accessed at <https://quizlet.com/>, is a platform that provides digital flashcards and various study modes beyond traditional flashcard methods. This platform appeals to a multitude of learners that are into a collaborative gamified learning experience. Quizlet's platforms include flashcard quizzes, matching games and practice tests which aid the users to maximize their learning experience through these different learning methods. This platform's features include audio and images, in addition to their artificial intelligence (AI) powered study modes that can personalize learning to each student. Additionally, Quizlet's website allows users to share and modify user-generated flashcard sets covering multiple subjects, making this platform a great tool for group study and classroom integration. With these multiple ways of learning on Quizlet's platform, the flashcard transforms learning into a more engaging and competitive experience. The overall goal of this project is to evaluate the websites of Brainscape and Quizlet on their effectiveness of flashcard-based learning, its usability, and educational aspects (Dunlosky et al., 2013).

Modified Educational Evaluation Rubric

The original rubric created by Harmon and Reeves (1998), provided a general evaluation for educational websites, however, after further research our team has modified the rubric as the focus on this evaluation centers around the effectiveness of flashcard-based learning. As a result, we have added the following criteria to the modified evaluation rubric:

- **Adaptive Learning Features:** As Brainscape uses an adaptive algorithm, it is important to determine whether Quizlet provides the same customization on their platform.
- I. **Variety of Study Modes:** Quizlet offers many game features and quizzes, so it was important to evaluate this feature.
- **Collaboration and Sharing:** As both platforms have this capability, it was important to include this as part of the evaluation rubric.

Evaluation Assessment Overview

After completing the evaluation for both Brainscape and Quizlet, it was interesting to see that both platforms excel in distinct aspects of digital flashcard-based learning. Quizlet emerged as the overall stronger platform due to the diverse study modes coupled with the collaborative study features and multimedia integration. When looking at Brainscape, this platform excels in the adaptive learning features that offer a more structured and tailored personal approach to learning. Brainscape scored 25 out of 30 which emphasized its strengths in adaptative learning and its structure to overall learning. Quizlet received a higher score of 26 out of 30, due to its low cost, audio and video abilities, and gamified learning experiences. A crucial factor in Brainscape's loss to Quizlet is due to its lack of extensive study modes and higher cost for a premium subscription, thus making Quizlet's platform a more appealing option for learners that seek continuous affordability, diverse learning activities, and gamified study mode experiences. The decision between the two platforms depends on the user's preferences to enhance their learning needs but our group understands why Quizlet is the overall pick for learners.

Compare and Contrast

After evaluating Brainscape and Quizlet's website, these two websites share a common goal of facilitating efficient flashcard-based learning, but their approach to learning these methods differs vastly when considering critical factors such as adaptive learning, cost, gamification, and overall user experience.

Adaptive Learning Features

One of the most noticeable differences between the two platforms is the adaptive learning features. To maximize retention and efficiency, Brainscape offers a tailored approach to this concept, ensuring that the learner continues to spend more time reinforcing weaker topics and less time on the topics they have already mastered. In contrast, Quizlet offers a range of interactive study modes and games but does not employ the same level of algorithm adaptation to optimize learning efficiency, thus forcing users to become self-reliant and create their own study patterns.

Cost Comparison

Cost was another crucial consideration when comparing these two platforms. As both platforms require a premium subscription for full access, Quizlet offers a more budget-friendly option at \$35.99 per year making it a more attractive option for students and casual learners. In contrast, Brainscape's Pro plan is priced a bit higher at \$96.00 per year to reflect its focus on adaptive learning. Although Brainscape's additional cost can be justified for its top-tier features, budget conscious learners may find Quizlet's pricing more affordable.

Gamification and Engagement

Gamification and engagement are another critical area of discussion. Quizlet's gamified way of learning allows users to increase their motivation and overall retention thus making it more appealing to younger audiences and a classroom setting (Hamari et al., 2014). In contrast,

Brainscape focuses on minimalism that caters to learners that prefer a more distraction-free and individualized structured approach to learning.

Findings and Recommendations

Understanding the strengths and limitations of these platforms is crucial for educators and learners to select the most appropriate flashcard-based study tool that will enable them to achieve their goals. With the rapid rise of online learning, these two platforms provide valuable opportunities for learners to reap the benefits of digital learning that aims to enhance one's ability to retain and recall information efficiently. The comparison within this study provided insights into which platform is more effective for flashcard-based learning through a thorough evaluation rubric that is considered crucial factors.

As these digital learning tools continue to evolve, flashcard-based learning platforms such as Brainscape and Quizlet have revolutionized the way students approach retention and memorization. The choice between Brainscape and Quizlet depends on a learner's study habits. Brainscape uses a data-driven approach to reinforce challenging concepts and suits those who thrive on structure and repetition. Its spaced repetition system focuses on weak areas, making it particularly useful for long-term retention and exam preparation. Quizlet, on the other hand, offers greater flexibility and engagement. With multiple study modes, interactive features, and collaborative tools, it appeals to students who prefer variety in their study methods. Whether for self-paced review, group study, or classroom activities, Quizlet provides more opportunities for interaction than Brainscape. Ultimately, the right choice depends on whether a student values a structured, personalized approach (Brainscape) or a more interactive, social experience (Quizlet).

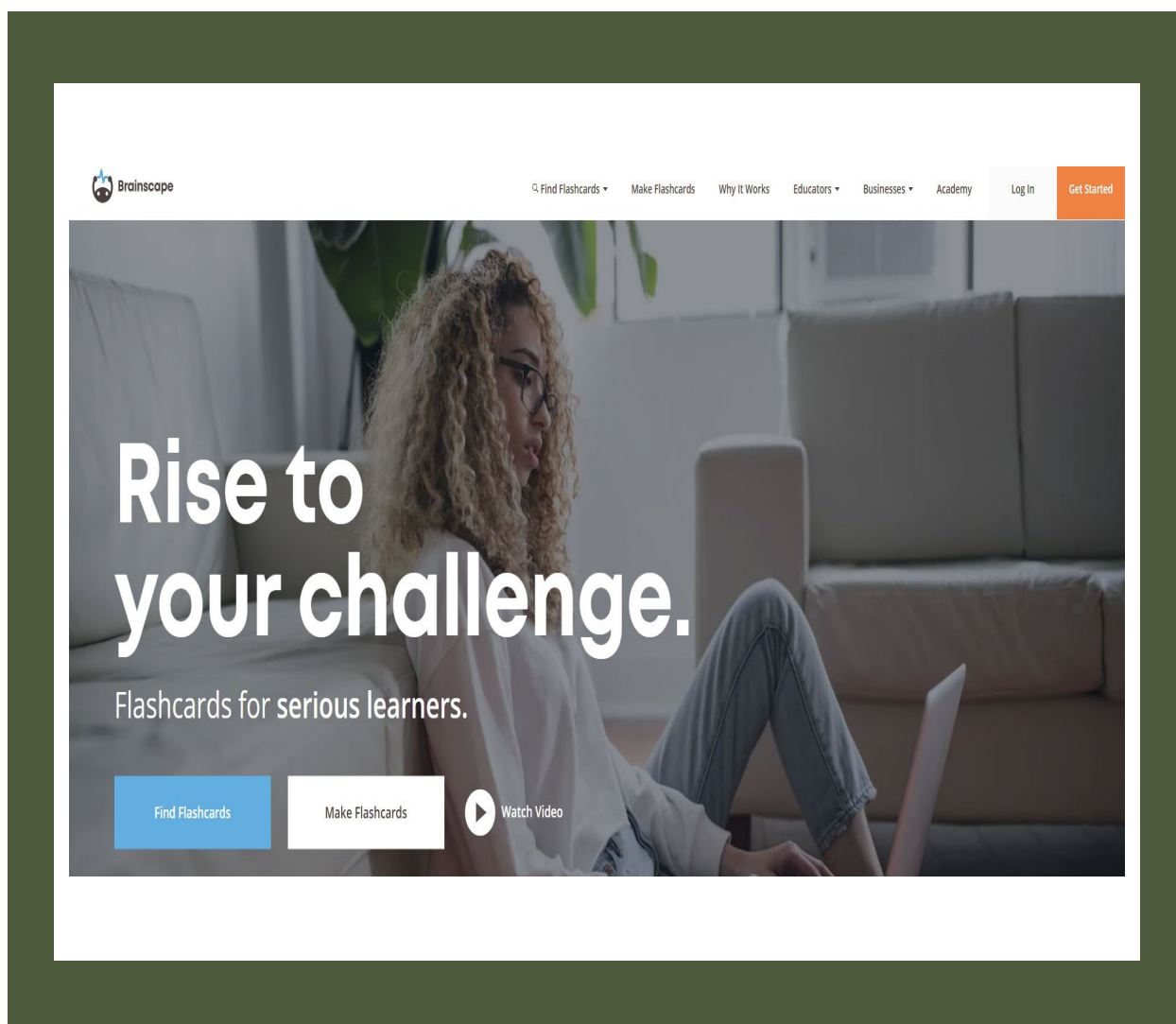
