Analysis

Identify the problem or instructional need. Understanding the learning needs, goals, and the audience.
What are the learning needs?

Design

Create a blueprint for the instructional materials. Develop detailed learning objectives. Create a structured plan for instruction.
How will the content be structured and taught?

Development

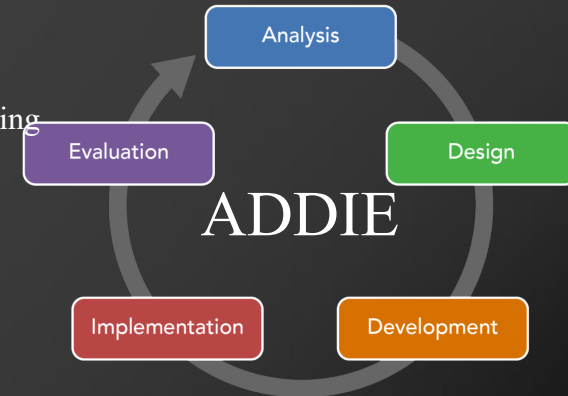
Create and assemble the instructional materials based on the design plan.
What materials and resources need to be created?

Implementation

Deliver or deploy the instructional materials to the learners. Facilitate learning, which could involve teaching, providing feedback, or offering technical support
How will the instruction be delivered?

Evaluation

Assess the effectiveness of the instruction and the learning outcomes. Carry out summative evaluations. Insight into the success of the instructional materials and opportunities for improvement
Did the learning objectives get achieved, and how can it be improved?
